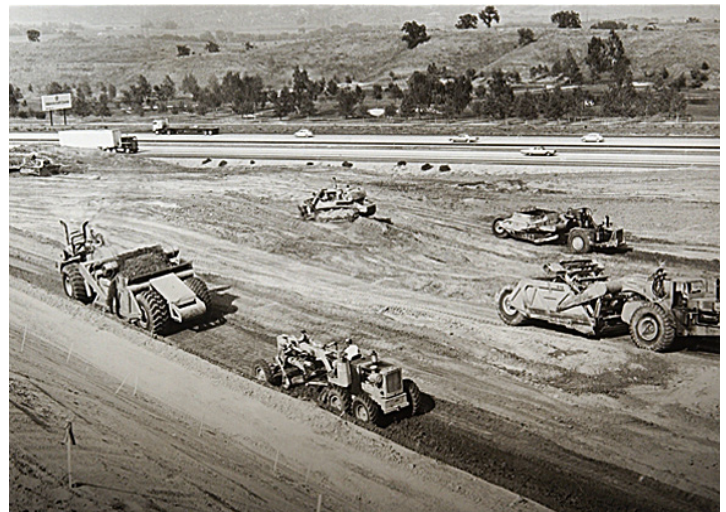




WORKING ON THE RANCH



C.A. Rasmussen has landed some of the early street work for the development of the Newhall Ranch project in Santa Clarita Valley with Five Points Development. This high profile job is claimed to be one of the last master planned projects in Southern California. When complete the Ranch will have built over 20,000 new homes.

The first of three contracts includes the widening and reconstruction of Magic Mountain Parkway. This will be one of the main entrances into the development. The work requires CA Rasmussen removing a portion of Magic Mountain Parkway that founder Carl Rasmussen built for the developer, at the time Newhall Land and Farming over 40 years ago.

In order to keep traffic flowing to Magic Mountain, C. A. Rasmussen will complete the work in 4 stages. Additionally, Rasmussen will utilize its modern fleet of heavy equipment to meet the developers requirement of tier 4 compliant engines to be used on the project. Project Manager Thomas Tan has been tasked with the management of the three contracts with all work slated to be complete by the end of the year. The completion of the contracts included paving over 60,000 tons of asphalt and base along with the placement of sidewalk and curb and gutter.

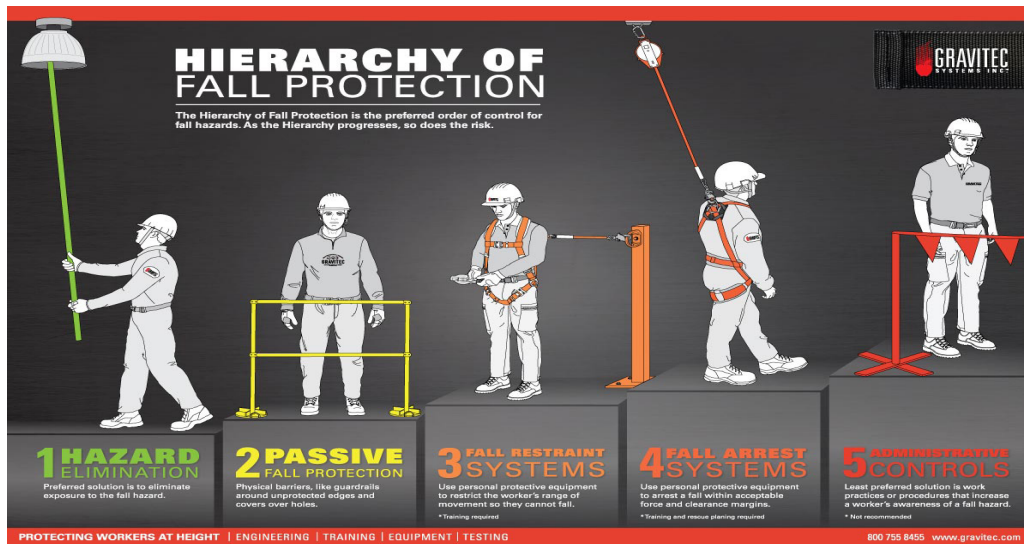


Focus on Safety

FALLS ARE THE LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH IN CONSTRUCTION



Since 2003 falls from heights in construction have been the leading cause for fatalities. Here at C. A. Rasmussen we have no accidents resulting in serious injury or death from falls above 6' or more. Our crews are working safe at eliminating hazards, using guard rails, wearing their safety harnesses, using fall arrest systems, and even using administrative controls preventing employees and vehicles from being exposed to leaning edges.
